R-E-S-P-E-C-T



Morning Church!

Soul singer Aretha Franklin is famous for her R-E-S-P-E-C-T anthem. Comedian Rodney Dangerfield bemoaned he never received respect from others. Respect is a virtue we offer our Dear Neighbor, and it is the gospel's expectation of us.

Several years ago, my family gathered in Atlanta for my grandniece's Bat Mitzvah. I participated in the ceremony by placing the tallits (prayer shawl) over my niece's shoulders. The tallits is worn when one reads or studies the Torah. The 613 knots on the fringes and its four edges symbolize the 613 Laws recorded in the Torah.

Her *Shabbat* Service concluded with the marvelous party in her cousin's home. Many acts of kindness and respect highlighted our time together. None us experienced tension over our religious differences. Instead, we shared loving respect so characteristic of *all* the Daughters and Sons of the Commandment of Love. The SSJ's Constitution says, we are called to "...love God, and neighbor without distinction." Unlike the reception Jesus received when he went to his home synagogue, everyone who participated in Stella's *Bat Mitzvah* showed and received *respect and love without distinction*.

As I write this homily before Chapter, what percolates to the top are the centuries-long hostilities between Israel and the Palestinian radicals of Hamas; and Putin's tyrannical invasion and bombing of Ukraine 28 months ago.

In being tribal, narrow-minded and distrustful, people are unable to see others as Children of God. The prophet Ezekiel reminds us that those who are "hard of face and obstinate of heart" fail to recognize and respect the prophets in there midst (or their Dear Neighbor, either!).

Let's live a *mitzvah-centered life*, as those who strive to live God's Commandment of Love. Do more than just dance to Aretha's R-E-S-P-E-C-T. Clothe yourselves with the inclusive love of God, who respects each of us and all of us \sim and calls us to respect each other. Welcome and respect the prophetic voices among us calling us to ongoing conversion of heart. It's who we are called to be \sim and say we are.

Prophets

In today's gospel, Jesus is in the *synagogue* preaching. A synagogue (sin-no-gog) is a house of worship/church for the Jewish people. The synagogue in today's gospel is found in Jesus' hometown, Nazareth.

When the people from Nazareth heard Jesus preach, they found it hard to believe in him and what he said. Some of the people of Nazareth thought they knew him because they watched him grow up and they knew his family.

Jesus spoke with great wisdom and he had done many mighty deed to show the people he had been sent to them by God as their teacher and *prophet*.

A prophet (prah-fit) is a person who speaks for God; helps the people look to a future full of hope; reminds the people to care for the poor and to be faithful to God.

When you were baptized, you were anointed with a holy oil called, chrism (chriz-um). As the priest made the Sign of the Cross on your forehead, he said these words:

"I anoint you priest, **prophet**, and king (leader).



BE a PROPHET for God!

Baptism calls you to serve others (priest); to speak for God (prophet); and to be a leader by your good example \sim even when others don't listen to or accept you \sim just like they did not listen to or accept Jesus.
