Morning Church!

Pentecost, the birthday of our Church, originated as the Jewish Feast of First Harvest. It is known as a "pilgrim" festival because, in Bible times, all Jewish males were required to observe it by visiting the Temple in Jerusalem to reaffirm their commitment to God.

Jesus' followers observed this feast differently. They knew it as the *Festival of the Harvest*. On this day, Jews would travel to Jerusalem to give thanks to God and to sell the first fruits of their fields. From Passover to Shavuot (50 days later), they brought their winter crops to the Temple: grapes, figs, pomegranate, olives, dates, or barley, their first fruits, in joyous celebration with gratitude for God's providing these blessings. Their journey to the Temple in Jerusalem would be accompanied by music and song.

Today, the Church celebrates Pentecost differently than our Jewish ancestors in faith; it's the Birthday of our Church, the 50^{th} day after Easter. On this day, Jesus fulfilled his promise to send the Holy Spirit to grace, lead, and teach the First Followers, and all of us, how to carry out his mission. Jesus' mission: go out to all the world and proclaim his life, death, and resurrection in word and deed ~ and mostly by your example.

The Holy Spirit's fire ignited the disciples' hearts and propelled them out of their gathering place into the streets. There they preached the Risen Christ with courage and conviction. Their fierce persuasion drew 3,000 to be baptized that day!

How persuasive is your life that it leads others to Jesus, leads others to serve, forgive, and unite others to Jesus through the power of the Holy Spirit?

The Birthday of the Church is your birthday, too. It's your day to celebrate being a Child of God, a Child of Grace and the Faith faith God entrusted to you at Baptism. Reflect on how you live your faith and the depth of your desire to grow in faith, compassion, empathy, and an unwavering sense of justice.

In the wake of the increasing gun violence in our country, today pleads for your active response to stand over and against this anti-birthday movement unique in all the world to our country. How can you engage this issue from your heart and conviction of faith?

Birthdays are annual celebrations that offer you an opportunity to reflect on how and where your journey is going. Also, it's a day to re-ignite your heart and fiercely and freely give grateful praise for the richness of your life. Today's the day to celebrate your birth into the Promise of Everlasting Life.

Last Saturday, Diego Alejandro Carrion Espino, son of Julia and Diego, received his birth certificate. Infant Diego is an answer to hundreds of prayers, including mine.

As his parents and family celebrate his birth, the Church celebrated her birthday, Pentecost. Soon, Diego will celebrate his birthday into the Church.

Next year, when he celebrates his 1st birthday, he will also celebrate Pentecost with his Church family.


Come Holy Spirit!

Jesus' disciples, along with Mary, and other believers came together in one place to pray for the Holy Spirit to come to them as Jesus had told them before he returned to heaven.


