

¡Buenos días, Iglesia!

La familia es nuestra primera relación. En la mezcla de la familia, aprendemos, principalmente con el ejemplo, cómo tener una relación y cómo no tenerla. Para que podamos convertirnos en un signo de la presencia de Dios como familia, debemos permanecer comprometidos con las buenas y las malas de nuestras relaciones familiares. Básicamente, la familia está llamada a vivir junta su Bautismo

*“...en lo bueno y en lo malo, en la riqueza, en la pobreza, en la enfermedad
y en la salud, hasta la muerte...”*

Colosenses proclama en frases concisas cómo estar y permanecer en una relación. Cada frase individual es una pegatina espiritual para el parachoques... soportáos unos a otros... perdonaos unos a otros... dedícate al agradecimiento... Deja que la Palabra de Cristo, rica como es, habite en ti... todo en el nombre del Señor Jesús...

Las virtudes enumeradas en la epístola de Pablo son la gracia que une todas las relaciones... compasión, bondad, humildad, gentileza y paciencia..." Imagine la transformación de las relaciones familiares si estas virtudes se vivieran en cada hogar/Iglesia doméstica, cuando ¡El sarcasmo y el desánimo son reemplazados por estas virtudes vivificantes! La primera lectura (Eclesiástico, de la literatura sapiencial), dice que una familia moldeada en el camino de la virtud se convierte en “una casa levantada en la justicia”.

La angustia de la crianza de los hijos hoy se puede resumir en la descorazonadora declaración de María a Jesús: “¿Por qué nos has hecho esto?””. La naturaleza compulsiva de la juventud es el detonante aquí. Los niños actúan por capricho, sin pensar mucho en los efectos o consecuencias de sus palabras o acciones. Para asegurar “una casa educada en la justicia”, los padres deben esforzarse por comunicar a sus hijos que son amados, ofrecer disciplina constante, límites claros y las consecuencias de sus decisiones sin amor. El Rito del Bautismo dice: "Los padres son los primeros y mejores maestros de sus hijos". Así los niños aprenden lo que viven y ven en casa. La Fiesta de la Sagrada Familia es una invitación para que las familias renueven y fortalezcan sus relaciones, sanen lo herido y se acerquen a Dios y a los demás. Es un recordatorio de que todos nosotros, ya sea que estemos relacionados "por sangre" o no, todos somos hijos de Dios, y todos somos parte de la familia de Dios.

Morning, Church!

Family is our first relationship. In the mix of family, we learn, mostly by example, how to be in relationship and how not to be in relationship. For us to become a sign of God's presence as a family, we need to stay committed to the thick and thin of our family relationships. Basically, the family is called to live their Baptism together

"...for better for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health, until death..."

Colossians proclaims in pithy sentences how to be in and stay in relationship. Each individual sentence is a spiritual bumper sticker....*bear with one another...forgive one another...dedicated yourself to thankfulness...Let the Word of Christ, rich as it is, dwell in you...do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus...*


The virtues listed in Paul's epistle are the gluing grace of every relationship....*compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience...*" Imagine the transformation of family relationships if these virtues were lived in each household/Domestic Church, when sarcasm and discouragement are replaced by these life-giving virtues! Reading I (Sirach, from Wisdom literature), says a family molded in the way of virtue becomes "*a house raised in justice.*"

The angst of parenting today can be summed up in Mary's dismaying statement to Jesus, "*Why have you done this to us?*" The compulsive nature of youth is the igniter here. Children act on a whim, with little thought of the effects or consequences of their words or actions. To insure "*a house raised in justice*", parents must strive to communicate to their children that they are loved, offer consistent discipline, clear boundaries, and the consequences for their unloving choices. The Baptismal Rite says, "Parents are the first and best teachers of their children." So children learn what they live and see at home.

The Feast of the Holy Family is an invitation for families to renew and strengthen their relationships, to heal what is wounded, and to draw closer to God and one another. It's a reminder that all of us, whether we are related 'by blood' or not, all of us are Children of God, and all of us are part of God's family.


Prayer After an Election



Happy Birthday, Jesus!


Today we celebrate Jesus' Birthday!
