# 'Father Forgive'

Following the bombing of the mediaeval Cathedral in 1940, Provost Howard had these words inscribed on the wall behind the Altar of the ruined building.

*"Father Forgive"* is used as the response in the *Coventry Litany of Reconciliation*, which is prayed in the new Cathedral every weekday at noon and is used throughout the world by the Community of the Cross of Nails.

All have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. The hatred which divides nation from nation, race from race, class from class, **Father, forgive.** 

The covetous desires of people and nations to possess what is not their own, Father, forgive.

The greed which exploits the work of human hands and lays waste the earth, *Father, forgive.* 

Our envy of the welfare and happiness of others, Father, forgive.

Our indifference to the plight of the imprisoned, the homeless, the refugee, Father, forgive.

The lust which dishonours the bodies of men, women and children, *Father, forgive.* 

The pride which leads us to trust in ourselves and not in God, *Father, forgive.* 

Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

## Morning Church!

Try as you may, to deny it, you are inextricably tied to everyone and everything. It's called "The ties that bind..." Relationships are sacred, relentless tetherings so core to your faithjourney.God's tethering is not arbitrary. You are intimately, eternally connected to God and all of Creation. Your tetherings are linked to expectations meant to fully engage you in relationship with God, your Dear Neighbor, and Creation.

As relationships grow, so do their expectations. Sometimes others' expectations of you are very demanding or even unrealistic, and vice versa. Relationships constantly stretche your heart and teach you how to yield; how to say "yes" or "no" for the right reasons. Most of all, relationship mentor your heart so you will learn what it means to surrender your will and your ways to God's will and God's ways, in the service of others.

The Risen Christ knew the hearts of his disciples. They were traumatized and needed healing and encouragement. Since their first time they said "yes" to his open invitation and outstretched hand and entered into a graced relationship with him. Their first "yes" to follow him, lead to other, more demanding "yeses". With great care, Jesus taught them to generously serve others without counting the cost.

You are just like the disciples. When you are confronted by a trauma, loss, or any shocking event, you often act like the disciples, who desperately wanted their life to return to its normalcy and routines. After Holy Week's astonishing events and the inconceivable Resurrection encounters with Jesus, they went right back to what they knew and what would bring them instant comfort:

They went fishing!

Does it seem to you, they untethered themselves from Jesus and their recent experiences too fast? Or is it, that they're so overwhelmed by their fears and guilt that they fallback on what makes them feel more secure?

Jesus sees the evocative beach breakfast as the precise moment for his followers to reaffirm their faith in him  $\sim$  and to refocus them on his mission.

Today is your opportunity to stretch yourself to see things Christ's way. Cast your net over the *right side* of the boat; to do everything you can to stay tethered to Jesus; and to seek out ways to stretch your heart for the gospel's sake.

## Reflect on this:

Jesus forgives, then feeds his followers. Then he asks *them to forgive and feed* others in his name.

Do you love Jesus? Tend to others. Serve them as they need to be served. Do you love Jesus? Feed others ~ with your gifts and the grace of your presence. Do you love Jesus? Know loving Jesus will stretched you to tend and feed all your relationships

Ultimately, your relationship with Jesus requires you to fully surrender to God's will as Jesus did; to go places you don't want to go; and to do things you don't want to do. That's what following Jesus means.

Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!
