


During Lent, the Paschal Mystery of Jesus' suffering and death are in the gospel foreground. No temptations to power, prestige, or popularity will drag him into the gloom that is pride's darkness. He is bravely in the foreground. He says what he wants to say, he proclaims his place in the Mystery that is beyond the Satan's reach.

When his achy hunger pangs are prodded, Jesus responds with a pure fast of forty days. When his desire to control his own life is gored and pierced, he responds with the sure conviction of confidence: he is totally safe in God's care. As he is challenged to dominate, he responds with Godly grace: nothing can supplant the worship or service of God. Nothing. And no one.

The Lenten Season brings *bravery* into the foreground. Bring to the foreground God's grace that overcomes temptation in this Desert of Choices ~ and not only for Forty Days! God's grace is braver, stronger, and more enduring than any and every temptation. This Lenten Season is your graced time. So stand in the foreground of your life; pray, fast and be generously sacrificial with your time, talent, and your treasure. Show how big our brave is in Christ Jesus.

In today's Gospel story, Jesus goes out into the desert to fast and pray No. for forty days. In the forty days THANKS of Lent, the Church asks us to fast, give alms, and pray.

In Lent we don't eat meat on Fridays. Many people give up things like candy or dessert for all of Lent. When we give up food that we like, it reminds us that food isn't the only thing we need-we need God too!

Giving alms means giving money or things to the poor or the Church. God lets there be people who need our help so that we can become better by helping them!




