

These are days of joyous fulfillment. Throughout Salvation history God kept every promise made to us. God chose to do so, because *it's the way God is*. God makes and keeps promises and continually leads us by the Light who is Christ. In Christ, we have The Way to follow. Prayer. Sacraments, and Community Life are graced signposts which faith us through every burned bridge, pothole, or barrel-lined construction site and illumine The Way.



The Light that guides us is Traveling Mercy, especially when you feel, or are, miserably lost. Be wise. Your faithjourney is one of limitless do-overs. You've got this! Once again, be wise. Notice and heed your soul's leanings when directed to take an unfamiliar, or more circuitous route Home. This unusual, and probably uncomfortable Way, will give you opportunities to share your gifts and keep you faithful to The Way and The Light.


Mary the Mother of God

On the first day of the year we celebrate the feast day of Mary, the Mother of God.


If you didn't have a mother and God let you design your own mother, what would she be like? Well, God did get to make His own Mother! Can you even imagine how perfect she was?
