SYNODALITY: LOVE MEANS WALKING TOGETHER

Communion, Participation, and Mission.

What is the deepest desire of your heart?

Morning, Church!

Who does he think he is? The undercurrent of judgment, once just part of rumor mills explodes in their faces of Jeremiah and Jesus,. The judging, rejecting, and misunderstandings of their prophetic presence will build and crescendo quickly until the judging, misunderstandings, the rumors kill them.

For Jesus, it started in last week's gospel, in his inaugural address, as he cited the prophet Isaiah and proclaims, that, in him "scripture is fulfilled." In Christ, the Anointed One, the poor hear glad tidings; captives receive liberty; the blind receive sight; and the oppressed are freed. In Christ, the Good News is The Word Made Flesh. In Christ, all the promises made to us by God are kept. As Jesus proclaims Isaiah's prophecy, he tells his neighbors, and us, who he is.

Christ's example of servant-leadership is visible, tangible, "sense-able" and doable. *He offers* Good News so people can hear it and take it to heart. *He offers* true and lasting freedom to those captivated by addictive behaviors. *He offers* God's holy vision to those blinded by self-centered living and he *offers* the unrestricted peace of conviction to those entangled in worries, self-pity, concerned about what others says about or think of them. .

To offer these graces means to offer companionship in nonjudgmental, compassionate presence. This is the surest way to en flesh Love, so often made abstract, shapeless, or saccharinized in song. Jesus' mission is to model how he wants his followers to respond in love: patience, kindness, appreciation, self-control, balance, avowing a love that "*bears all things, endures all things.*"

To be Christ's disciple, become a servant-leader. Make Love real. Do the Gospel in concrete ways. Be *the Living Word* and *the Blessed Sacrament* among the Body of Christ. As baptized Christians, you are called to be the *visible presence* of the Invisible God.

For the sake of Love, listen to and honor the prophets in our midst who call you to a genuine change of heart. Ask for God's grace to heal your tendencies to be jealous or rude, and to replace them with a willing appreciation when others are strive to follow Jesus.

Being patient and kind is so underrated. Seek to put others' needs first. Check quick temperedness with self-control. Let go of your bruised and brooding ego when you feel injured. Be joyful and grateful when you experience judgment, rejection, or misunderstanding. You must be doing something right because you know who and whose you are.



So when you're being "run out of town" by judgments, rejections, and misunderstandings, get in front of the crowd and make it look like a parade.

That's what Love does and Love never fails.
